This summer is pretty hot too. I don't want to go outside, so I'll just turn on the air conditioner and stay at home.

It really is hot, isn't it! By the way, have you heard of "cool sharing?"





Cool sharing?'

"Cool share" is a way of sharing the cool air at public facilities and stores by going to such cool places in the heat of the day, instead of using the air conditioning at your house.



Results of cool sharing

Reduce carbon dioxide

By using electricity, much carbon dioxide is emitted, which is a cause of global warming.

Save energy at home

By cool sharing during the peak electricity use daytime hours of July - September, energy usage can be reduced by approximately 70%, and your electricity bill will be less expensive as well.

In addition, by gathering together with others for "cool sharing," families and city residents can get to know each other better, thus energizing the city.

What kinds of places are good for cool sharing?









You can cool share by going to public facilities like the city hall or library, or at stores like supermarkets, or at universities, cafes, or restaurants too.

You can also cool share in nature! Be refreshed at a waterfall, park, or other shady place.





Cool sharing by gathering at a friend's house is a good idea too!

"Cool sharing" is taking place in Utsunomiya from 1pm to 4pm from July to September.


Utsunomiya Garbage Info App

It can be used in Japanese, English, Korean or Chinese (simplified Chinese characters).

Temporary Welfare Benefits



In April 2014 the consumer tax increased to 8%, so there is a temporary welfare benefit available to for people with a low income in order to reduce the burden. From the end of August to the start of September it will mail the application form via post to people who may be eligible to receive it. The method for receiving it is generally via bank account money transfer.

Recipients:

- People with a citizen's registration for Utsunomiya on January 1, 2015.
- People who are not being taxed for the 2015 Citizen's Tax (However, people who are dependents of someone taxed for the Citizen's Tax, or people who are receiving public assistance are not eligible.)
- Reception period:

September 1 – February 1, 2016

O How to apply:

- Apply via postal mail
- Apply at: City Hall 1st floor Citizen's Hall (September – October), 16th floor Head Quarters (November – February), local residents' association centers, local residents' centers, branch offices, Tawara & Okamoto Offices

Q&A:

- **Q:** I moved to Utsunomiya after January 1, 2015, so can receive the welfare benefits in Utsunomiya?
- **A:** No, you can receive it from the city/town you have a citizen's registration for January 1, 2015.
- **Q:** If a person who has an Utsunomiya citizen's registration left the country after January 1, 2015, can they receive the welfare benefits?
- **A:** Yes. **People who plan to leave the country in the future should inquire. Inquiries: **Rinji Fukushi Kyufu Kin Jisshi Honbu
