December 15 and January 15 are dates of rituals for the god of the Futaarayama Shrine, which are held twice a year. The December Otariya Festival is written in Japanese like this "冬渡祭," and the January Otariya Festival is written like this, "春渡祭."

The kanji characters are difference, but both are read as "Otariya," right? That seems kind of weird.





Good luck charms, such as old notes and daruma figures, etc. are burned in December at the festival, giving the sense that the year has come to an end.

During the January festival, amulets are burned, giving the sense that the New Year's celebration has come to an end.

In the evening, portable shrines are spun around, so I want to go watch!

Shingles (Herpes Zoster) Vaccination Cost Subsidizing Began

It is a skin disease caused by the same virus as chickenpox. When you get sick, your skin hurts and it gets and blisters form, etc. The pain can continue for a long time even after healing. It is also said that people over years old are more likely to get this disease, and one in three people will develop shingles by the age of 80. Prevention method In addition to getting vaccinated, it is important to take care of regular lifestyle habits, such as eating a balanced diet, sleeping properly, and exercising moderately.	
□ Vaccination cost subsidy □ Target persons: People age 50 or older with with resident registration in Utsunomiya City □ Subsidy amount: ① Live vaccine = 4,000 yen/time (Vaccination 1 time) ② Inactivated vaccine = 10,000yen/time (Vaccination 2 times) □ Vaccination cost: It depends on the cooperative medical institution, so if you want to find out, please contact a cooperative medical institution. (Rough estimate) ① Around 8,000 yen/time (Vaccination 1 time) ② Around 20,000 – 23,000 yen (Vaccination 2 times) □ Vaccination venues: Cooperative medical institutions listed on the Utsunomiya City website. □ Vaccination at a medical institution other than in Utsunomiya: After paying in full, if you apply to the Health Issue Prevention Division (Hoken Youbou-ka), the subsidy will be paid later. □ Application method: Send a copy of your bill, receipt (original), and deposit bankbook for your account directly or by mail to Health Issue Prevention Division, 972 Takebayashi-machi, 321-0974. □ Other: ① One vaccination and ② two vaccinations will be subsidized per person. The target persons are people who have been vaccinated on or after November 1. For more information, visit the Utsunomiya City website. Utsunomiya Children's Home Usage Guide

Children's homes are designed to provide appropriate play and living places and foster good health for elementary school students during after-school or long-term holidays whose guardians are away from home during the day due to work, etc.

- ∇ Target children: Children whose guardians are not home during the day due to work, etc.
- Application info.: People who want to use children's homes in the middle of the fiscal year can also apply.
 Please apply to the children's home you want to use by the 10th day of the month you desire use.
 (Ex. If you want to use starting in January ⇒ Apply by December 10)
- → Application method: Please write down the necessary information for the application form (which can also be printed from the Utsunomiya City website) located on the 13th floor of the Lifelong Learning Division for your child's elementary school's children's home, and send it to the elementary school together with certification documents.
- ∇ Other: It is mandatory that guardians pick up their children from children's homes. For more information, visit the Utsunomiya City website.

Interview

Melanie from France

We asked Melanie about her hometown of Lille, France's multi-ethnic society, lifestyle, favorite aspects of Japan, and dream to be a translator.



Bonjour! "Hello" in French

Melanie Giboudeau came to Japan 3 years ago. She is working as an English teacher.

UCIA: What kind of place is Lille?

Melanie: Lille is in northern France, and borders Belgium. There are beautiful buildings and townscape of the Middle Ages, with a university as well, and it is said to be a town of learning. Winter lasts a long time and it is cold. Stewed cuisine called cream stew is very delicious.

UCIA: Are there many foreigners living in France?

Melanie: At my school there were students studying from India, Africa, South America, etc. Because of that, there were many classes to learn about multiculturalism. People born in France can become French. It is possible to travel to and from neighboring countries in Europe without a visa, and it is also possible to live in such countries.

UCIA: What was your life like in France?

Melanie: I was surprised to see that things that are still usable are thrown out in Japanese garbage stations. French people are reluctant to throw things out, and use them carefully, fixing them as necessary.

UCIA: What aspects do you like about Japan?

Melanie: I like that stores are open on Sundays and fun events are held. It is possible to go out and about. In France, most stores are closed on Sundays, and there are few trains and buses as well, so usually people just stay at home. People can enjoy meals with their families, but it's a little sad for those living on their own.

UCIA: Is there anything you want to try doing?

Melanie: I am diligently studying Japanese now to pass the N2 test. I like translating, so once I become better at Japanese, I want to translate Japanese picture books into French and spread them in France.
