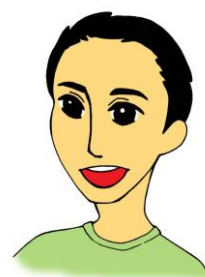


"Festa my Utsunomiya 2025" is upcoming.

Payment of Water & Sewage Charges

(Water Charges, Sewage Charges, etc.)

You can apply for automatic withdrawal from your bank account on the Internet.

You can easily apply for automatic withdrawals from your bank account for water and sewage charges on the Internet. Automatic withdrawals from your bank account will reduce your bill by 50 yen per two months, so please consider using this method. In addition, applicants can change their monthly transfer into a monthly payment method by dividing the two-month use into two separate installments, called “maitsuki furikae.” “Maitsuki furikae” is 25 yen cheaper per month.

You can also pay by credit card or electronic payment form.

“Credit card payment” for water and sewage charges and “electronic payment” via electronic notification are now possible. Once you register your credit card for payment, you can continue to pay using that method.

In addition, electronic payment slips are delivered to smartphones, etc. so unlike a paper payment slips, they cannot be damaged or lost. To pay by credit card or electronic payment, you need to register on the “Miyamizu Portal” portal site of the Waterworks Bureau. When you want to start or stop using the water and sewage system, you can do the procedures 24 hours a day from your smartphone or computer on the Internet. If you don't provide notification that you want to stop using it, you will have to pay the basic use fee even if you are no longer using the service.

Brady: We like camping. We enjoy fishing, cooking, and nature. When I camped in Hokkaido, there were deer and foxes. I go cycling with my oldest son, who is a high school student.

UCIA: What kind of work are you doing?

Brady: I am working as an English teacher. I teach at a kindergarten, UCIA, and at my own school. I was very happy when a shy elementary school student learned English, gained confidence, and opened up their heart.

UCIA: What is important about learning a foreign language?

Brady: Language learning is a lifelong process. Challenge yourself without being afraid of making mistakes, learn from that, and enjoy communicating.
